Basic information

The conference will take place from November 22 to 24, 2024, at the Faculty of Science of the University of South Bohemia in České Budějovice. A day earlier, on November 21, 2024, there will be a satellite symposium on human ethology. You are welcome to submit your abstracts for the symposium.

Key dates:

- October 13 – deadline for submission of conference abstracts
- October 28 to November 1 – participants will receive evaluations of the abstracts
- November 8 – deadline for responding to the abstract evaluation

Moreover, we are introducing three student workshops. Students can register for one of following:

- Student workshop A – telemetry: data collection and analysis
- Student workshop B – bioacoustics: using Raven, Luscinia and Avisoft software
- Student workshop C – ethological software: using Observer, Ethovision and Boris software

You can have lunch at the Biology Centre CAS canteen, from Thursday to Sunday. The conference banquet dinner will be held on Saturday, featuring a buffet, a toast, and a band. Accommodation is not provided as part of the conference nonetheless, here are few tips:

Student grants

Students can now apply for financial support to attend the conference. Selected students will receive €80 / 2000 CZK, which they can use at their discretion.

Requirements:

- The applicant must be a student at the time of the conference.
- The applicant must be a member of the Czech Ethological Society (CSEtS) or an applicant for membership in the CSEtS at the time of the conference.
- The applicant must register their abstract by **October 6, 2024**, and indicate their interest in participating in the competition during registration.
- The applicant must present their contribution (poster/presentation) in person at the conference.

Support will be granted to students based on the quality of their abstract. They will be informed of their selection in the week of October 28 to November 1, 2024. The funds will be transferred to the accounts of student society members after the conference and upon receipt of all necessary information (address, account number, etc.).
