

V European Conference on Behavioural Biology

16-18 July 2010, Ferrara, Italy

The ECBB is the joint meeting of the European scientific associations focusing on the study of animal behaviour. Representatives of these associations form the Committee of European Societies for Behavioural Biology (CESBB), which oversees the organization of each ECBB. Previous meetings were held in Münster (2002), Groningen (2004), Belfast (2006), and Dijon (2008).

The format of the conference will follow the tradition of previous ECBBs. There will be one plenary lecture in the morning, followed by parallel Symposia and Science Market sessions until the midafternoon tea break, when the Posters session will start.

Submission of Symposia and Science Market Proposals will open on 1 October 2009 and close on 31 December 2009. Submission of Abstracts for Symposia, Science Markets, and Poster contributions will open on 1 March 2010 and close on 30 April 2010.

Ferrara's most famous image is certainly that of its grand Renaissance. In 1995 UNESCO has included the historical centre of Ferrara in the list of World Cultural Heritage. For an extended visit, you will find uncountable attractions in the Province of Ferrara and the Region Emilia-Romagna.
